## 1. Introduction

### a. context: John chapter 13

- Jesus washes Disciples' feet
  - \* all 12 including Judas Iscariot
- Jesus introduces His troubled spirit (verses 18-30)
  - \* one of you will betray Me
  - \* Satan possesses heart of Judas Iscariot (Lk 22:3)
- Jesus begins His Last Supper with remaining 11 Disciples
  - \* Mt 26:17-35 including Peter's denials
  - \* Mk 14:12-26 Lord's Communion given to Disciples
  - \* Lk 22:1, 7-37 God's serving nature shown

### b. John chapter 14-17 Upper Room Discourse

- so much instruction given to Disciples in last days of Jesus' life

### c. Jesus predicting future immediate events

- Jesus will be glorified
  - \* return back to heaven
  - \* living in eternal light
- in a little while, you cannot come where I am going
- new command to love one another
  - \* badge of Jesus disciples?
  - \* love for each other
  - \* Jesus set example of loving them

3. How is the Son of Man glorified?
  - a. Not during Jesus mortal life on earth (Jn 7:37-39)
  - b. God of Israel glorified on earth because Jesus finished the work (job) God gave Him (Jn 17:4)
    - Jesus revealed God's name to men in the world (Jn 17:6, 8)
  - c. God glorified Jesus by raising Him from the dead (Acts 3:13-15)
  - d. God the Father made His Son a high priest in heaven (Heb 5:5-7, 9-10)
4. Disciples cannot find Jesus?
  - a. "You cannot come with Me where I go."
    - Jesus will be with them for only a short time more.
    - Peter, "Where are you going?", "Why cannot I follow you now?" (Jn 13:36-37)
    - ~~ba~~ - Peek-a-boo, "You shall not see Me, & again... you will see Me (Jn 16:16-20)
  - b. Jesus much earlier told Pharisees that they would not find Him
    - Jesus will return back to the Father who sent Him
    - Jn 7:32-36 will Jesus go to the Gentiles to teach them?
  - c. Jesus returns to His Father in heaven (Acts 1:9)
    - but Jesus will come again (Acts 1:11)
5. Love one another
  - a. Law of Christ (Gal 6:2)
    - fulfill (complete) this law
  - b. If you refuse to share this world's goods to brother's needs (1 Jn 3:17)
    - how can God's love be in him?
    - Love in words & actions (1 Jn 3:18)
  - c. Gal 5:14 law completed (fulfilled) in loving your neighbor as yourself
  - d. Permit brotherly love to continue (Heb 13:1)
  - e. Royal Law: Love your neighbor as yourself (James 2:8)
