Lord, Who Is Like Unto Thee? (God is Just)

Isaiah 46:9 Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,

Isaiah 45:21 Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me.

1. God is just. Isaiah 45:21b; Genesis 18:25; Psalm 19:9b; Revelation 19:2a

2. Because God is just, God punishes only the guilty (each individual is responsible). Genesis 18:25a

3. Because God is just, God requires restitution. Deuteronomy 22:1,7b

God's loving plan of salvation: God's grace and our faith in His Son Jesus Christ. God does not require us to pay restitution for His Son Jesus Christ because we cannot.
